ACADEMICS

ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY

All students are equipped with an Apple iPad, which allows students to experience an enhanced education. The 11:1 teacher to student ratio allows for a personalized classroom setting.



ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSE PROGRAM

Advanced Placement (AP) courses provide college-level curriculum developed by College Board, makers of the SAT, to high school students. Students are taught the course by Bishop Guilfoyle teachers during the regular school day. Our AP courses are as follows:

PROFESSORS IN RESIDENCE PROGRAM

- BUS 101: Wall Street 101: Business in a Global Society – 3 college credits
- HIST 195: Early & Medieval Church History and Architecture – 3 college credits

GRADUATE PROFILE

Traditionally Our Graduates:

- Earn a minimum of 28 academic credits with the majority earning 32 academic credits;
- Complete a minimum of 100 service hours;
- 100% who apply for admission are accepted to post-secondary institutions;
- 60% of our graduates were offered academic/merit-based scholarships; valued at over \$3.5 million dollars
- 100% performance measure for advanced placement core offerings;
- 40% earn college credits equivalent to at least one college semester;
- Top 10% exceed national SAT average by approximately 500 points;
- Top 30% exceed national SAT average by approximately 350 points;
- 100% college ready benchmark performance measure on SAT/ACT;
- Over 80% achieve GPA exceeding the academic criteria set by the National Honor Society
