SCHOOL CANCELLATIONS AND DELAYS

With winter weather upon us, notification of school delays and cancellations will be broadcast on local television and radio stations. Parents may also sign up to receive a text message by texting "y" to 68453. Virtual school days will be automatically implemented on weather-related school cancellations.

GUIDELINES: Students are required to email their attendance in to their period one teacher between 10:00 AM and 11:00 AM. The students' email needs to simply state that they are checking in for the day. Any student who fails to report their attendance will be marked absent for the day (student handbook guidelines on attendance will apply to virtual days). Students are required to log into their eBackpack account to access and complete the posted assignments for each of their scheduled classes. Students must complete and submit all posted work by 8:00 PM. Students are to email their teachers if they have any questions or concerns about the posted lesson or assignment. Each teacher will determine the means for students to submit classwork for the day, i.e. email, eBackpack, discussion board, etc.

RED THUMB REMINDER CAMPAIGN

The Bishop Guilfoyle Chapter of SADD will promote the Red Thumb Reminder Campaign to kick off the holiday season later this month. It is an old school solution to a new world problem and has been gaining momentum nationwide since its launch in August of 2013. According to the National Safety Council, 25 percent of all car accidents are caused by texting while driving. 1.6 million car accidents are the result of such distracted driving, and their research has shown that the risk of crashing increases eight times if the driver is texting. The Red Thumb Reminder is an anti-texting while driving campaign which asserts that red nail polish can be a cure for distracted driving. Participating students will paint their thumbnail with red nail polish as a reminder to avoid the risky behavior of texting while driving.

BG STUDENTS "MIX-ED IT UP"

Bishop Guilfoyle Catholic High School recently participated in the 13th annual Mix It Up at Lunch Day, a national campaign launched by the Southern Poverty Law Center's Teaching Tolerance project that encourages students to cross social boundaries. Mix It Up started with a simple idea: sit with someone new at lunch. On October 28th, students were asked to move out of their comfort zones and connect with someone new over lunch. Students were given conversation starters and asked to fill out surveys to encourage interaction. When students interact with those who are different from them, biases and misperceptions can fall away. It's a simple act that can have profound implications. Mix It Up at Lunch Day was sponsored by the International Student Ambassador Program.

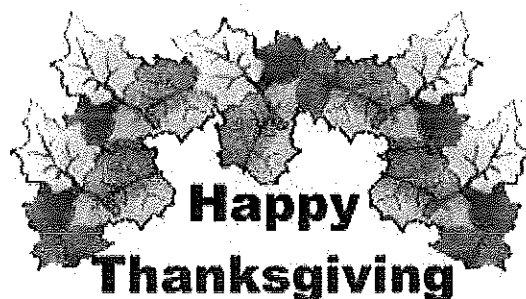

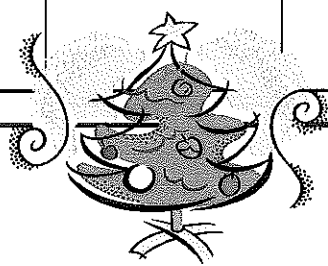
