Accelerated Pre-AP Preparatory Program

The vision is to provide a rigorous learning environment that fosters educational growth on multiple levels. A major focus of this accelerated program is to challenge your child's scholarly potential. The goal of the program is to identify academic enrichment that stimulates your child's passion for learning.

At a Glance

Classes are designed to establish strategies and methods for acquiring in-depth knowledge that centers on critical thinking skills. The course work requires students to demonstrate higher level thinking through a variety of assessments that exemplify the profile of the accelerated learner.

Vertical Curriculum Sequence Example

The following example flowchart outlines the Pre-AP through AP sequence of courses in English Language Arts.



Accelerated Pre-AP Preparatory Program Curriculum Grade Level 7 and 8

◆ Pre-AP English and Language Arts

Students will read and analyze literature in order to develop the literacy skills, vocabulary building, academic habits, and critical strategies to succeed in rigorous academic courses. In conjunction with literacy, students will develop composition skills that reflect the needed proficiencies for writing.

- ◆ *Pre-AP English and Language Arts I*
- ◆ *Pre-AP English and Language Arts II*

◆ Pre-AP Math

Students will identify advanced concepts that challenge their mathematical knowledge and skills, which entails algebraic problem solving and applications leading to competency for AP high school math curriculum.

- ◆ *Pre-AP Algebra I*
- ◆ *Pre-AP Algebra II*

◆ Pre-AP Science

Students will learn through a guided-inquiry based instructional model that provides students with direct experiences about scientific processes relative to their world. Instructional strategies include inquiry, science literacy, research, and STEM.

◆ Pre-AP Social Studies

Students will explore and examine various cultures, economics, government, and geography; in-depth study will include the history of Pre-Civil War America.

Students will demonstrate world language skills through oral, written, listening and reading activities. The study of the language will nurture an appreciation for cultural diversity, awareness, and understanding.

◆ Religion: Foundation and Faith

Students will explore the Catholic worldview through a special literary and multimedia model of learning that provides academic study of foundational doctrines and practices.

◆ TEAM — Technology, Enhanced Art and Music

Students will complete the TEAM component through courses in technology, art and music.
