



Memorandum of Understanding Catholic Secondary Schools of the Diocese of Altoona- Johnstown

Catholic schools are a preferred option in education because they allow the acquisition of knowledge without placing limits. The National Conference of Catholic Bishops, in their pastoral message on Catholic education To Teach as Jesus Did of November 1972, affirmed that an integration of religious truth and values with life “distinguishes the Catholic school from other schools. This is a matter of crucial importance today in view of contemporary trends and pressures to compartmentalize life and learning and to isolate the religious dimension of existence from other areas of human life.”

The principles of such an option are as follows:

1. Catholic schools are a preferred option for Catholic parents.
2. Catholic secondary education is an important and necessary ministry of the Church.
3. That option and that ministry must be made available to as many as possible.
4. That ministry must be viable pastorally and financially.
5. The Diocesan Church should financially assist parents according to need and to the extent that its finances will allow.
6. As in the past – Catholic parents need to consider Catholic schools as a priority for their children and are called to support them to the extent that they are able.
