Professor-In-Residence courses (PIR) are taught at Bishop Guilfoyle by Saint Francis University professors. These courses are mandatory Dual Enrollment, including all fees. Coursework and grading are aligned with university policy standards. In order to earn the college credits a student must apply and pay the college for the credits and maintain a “C” average or higher in the class. In these mandatory DE courses, high school credit will not be issued if college credit is not earned.
